## Amendment II to the Upper Hudson AVA petition

When the Upper Hudson AVA petition was accepted as perfected, its borders captured the extent of known viticulture in the area. Since then additional vineyards have been planted. This includes, Shernau Estates, Red Stone Ridge and Cambridge Mountain. These new vineyards are outside the north east border by approximately 3.5 miles. The three vineyards are shown in blue on the map below. Additionally a fourth vineyard, in blue, was planted in the summer of 2016. The amended border is shown in red. From the town of Hoosick Fall and north the border of the AVA includes land that is west of the Taconic Mountains. This amendment extends that border approximately 9 miles north through the Cambridge valley and then north northwest to the Town of Argyle, NY. This additional land is within the Growing Degree Day (GDD) band of the Upper Hudson Region.


