- Romaneé-Conti: a very reserved wine in its youth; its beauty lies in its uncanny ability to harmonize its elements and create a wine of consummate elegance and subtlety. Very different from the overtness of La Tâche or Richebourg.
- La Romanée: like Romanée-Conti, reserved in its youth; noted for its completeness and perfect harmony. With 20 years development in a good vintage, it shares much of the essential characteristics of Romanée-Conti, with slightly less refined tannins.
- 3. La Tâche: seduces with its sheer range of aromatic breadth and dazzles the senses with its complexity. Tends to be expressive, even in its youth.
- 4. **Richebourg:** sublimely perfumed, yet powerful, muscular, rich and dense, with a superb intensity and opulence.
- 5. **Romanée St-Vivant:** an intoxicating perfume of violets and blackberries, Asian spices, smoke, and exotic tea. Possibly the most seductive and captivating nose of any Burgundy. A wine of elegance and finesse.
