REVISITING MAP WORK

- Tracing or Trying to memorize labels on a map is inefficient
- Often mix up locations
- Trying to use language to solve a visual problem
- Memorizing that A is North of B instead of simply seeing the picture in front of you
- Instead activate your spatial memory and create your own map!


GUIDELINES

- Pick a Subject
- Choose your sources
- Eliminate unnecessary information
- Simplify the Map
- Draw



ANNOTATING YOUR MAP

- Include pertinent information
- Make yourself laugh
- Trigger Memories and Emotions
- Use Visual Information aka Doodle




BUILD ON IT

- Colour it in
- Save it
- Reiterate, Modify, Add, Draw from Memory

MORE TIPS

- Colour it in (Unusual Colours stand out)
- Use Fine Repetitive Detail (ie. River name instead of lines)
- Use Humour, make yourself laugh and trigger memories. The strong the emotion the better your memory.



LET'S TALK DOODLING

- Taught that doodling is bad
- Often stopped in Schoo
- Actually Extremely Useful
- Exercises creativity and Visual Memory

THINKING OR NOTETAKING

- Random Doodling even usefu
- Notetaking can be more efficient
- Easier to Add Emphasis
- Makes information more unique
- Compresses large amounts of information
- Watching a movie vs Reading a Book
- Downloading movie vs Ebook

TIPS FOR DOODLING

- Have fun
- Eliminate unnecessary details
- Be Silly
- Use Graphs instead of words
- Create word art for names

GOOGLE EARTH

- Life Changing
- Allows 3D Visualization of Places you've never been
- Includes Pictures
- Place Names
- As much or as little detail as you want



USING GOOGLE EARTH

- Create a Scavenger Hunt
- Find Specific Vineyards or Famous Monuments
- Find Signs or Wineries in Street View
- Understand the Slopes and Rivers
- Compare Wine maps with Real Life





REVISITING TASTING

- Flip the Order
- Visual Tasting

FLIP CLASS/TASTING ORDER

- Typical = Information about vast regions followed by tasting of several wines from those regions.
- Flipped = Taste a wine, find information about that wine, teach about the region
- Why?
- Creates interest and Context with tasting
- Challenges class/self to find informatio
- Builds on learning.
- Engages multiple learning methods and hunting for information gives little victories for your brain.




