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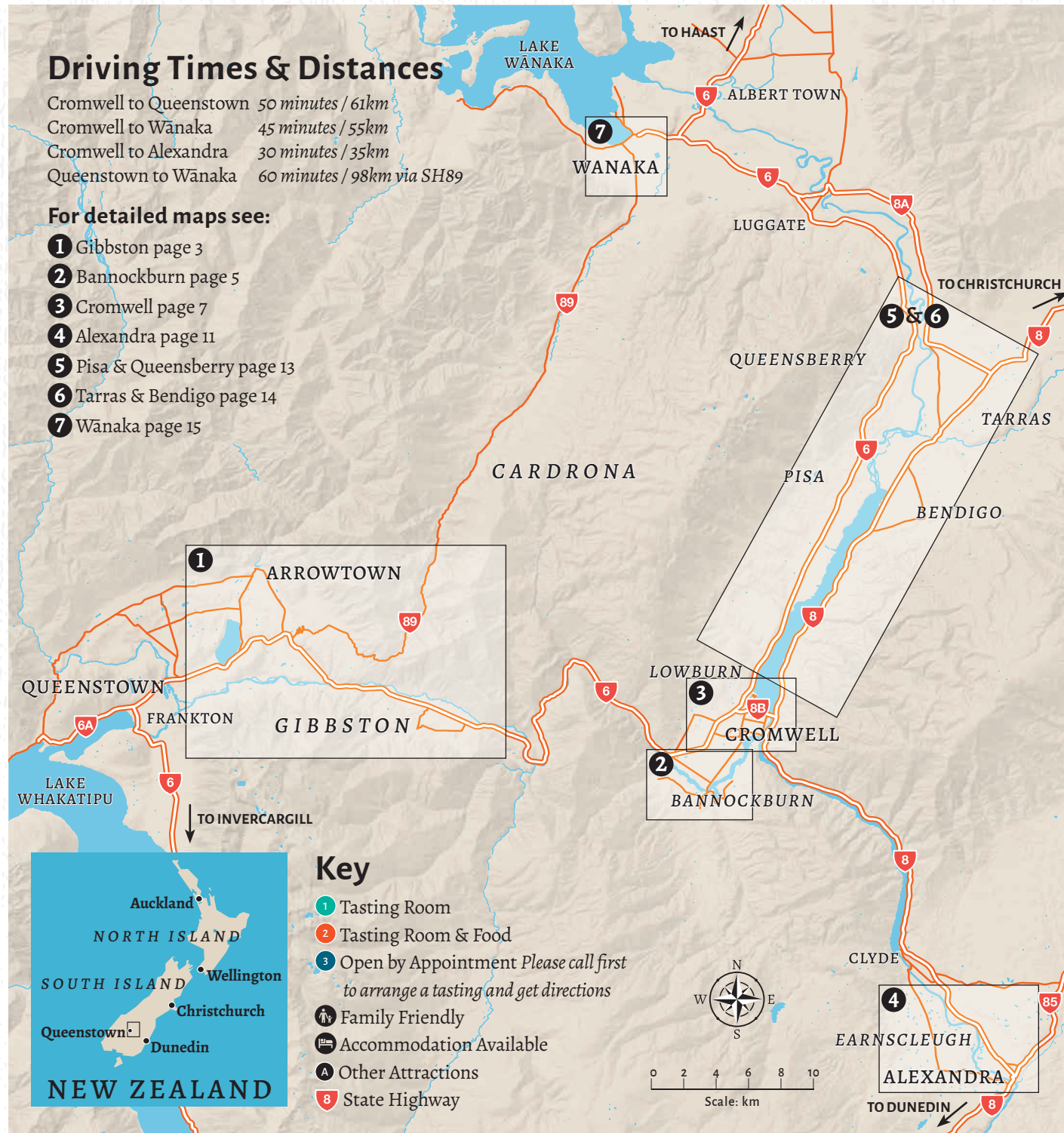

You can self-drive at your leisure or book a guided tour with one of our many experienced wine tour operators. The New Zealand drink driving limits for a driver 20 years and over is a breath alcohol limit of 250 micrograms (mcg) of alcohol per litre of breath and a blood alcohol limit of 50 mg of alcohol per 100ml of blood.

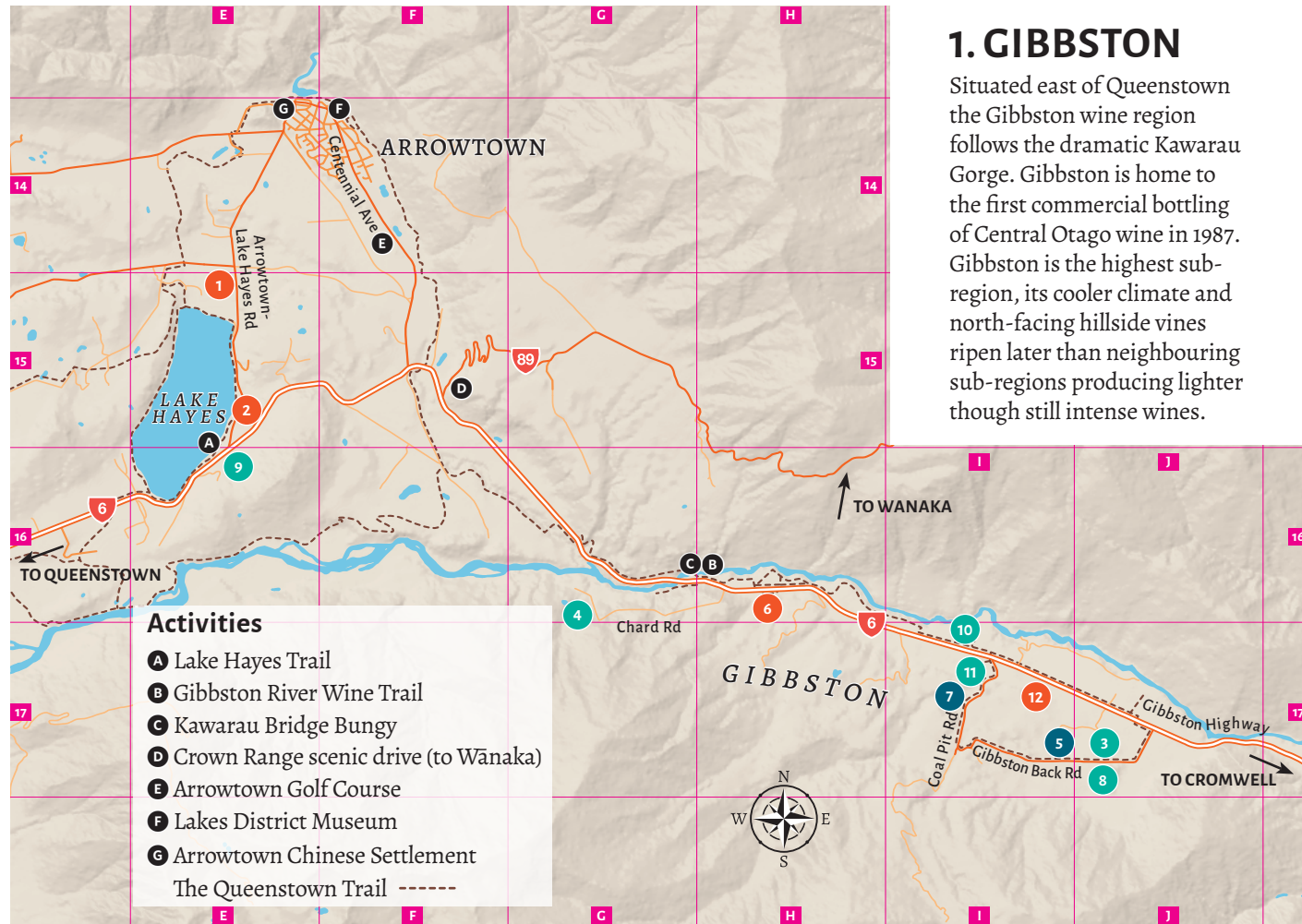

1. GIBBSTON

Situated east of Queenstown the Gibbston wine region follows the dramatic Kawarau Gorge. Gibbston is home to the first commercial bottling of Central Otago wine in 1987. Gibbston is the highest sub-region, its cooler climate and north-facing hillside vines ripen later than neighbouring sub-regions producing lighter though still intense wines.

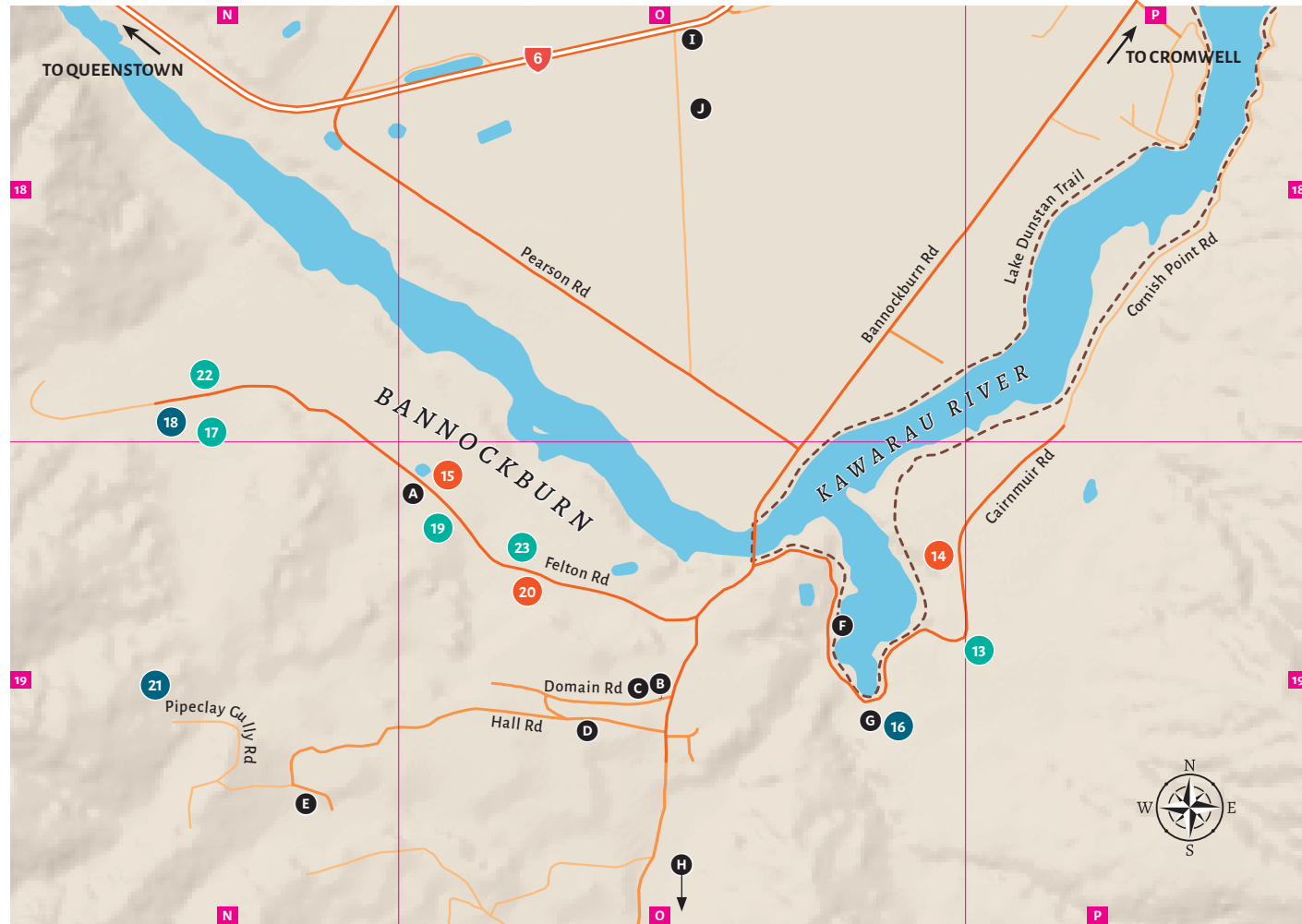

2. BANNOCKBURN

Bannockburn is situated on the southern banks of Lake Dunstan. The vineyards occupy one of the warmest, driest sites in the Central Otago wine growing area. The region has always been prosperous, initially with the region's rich goldfields and now with flourishing vineyards. Harvest can be up to a month ahead of other sub-regions, and the wines produced are known to be highly distinctive and complex.

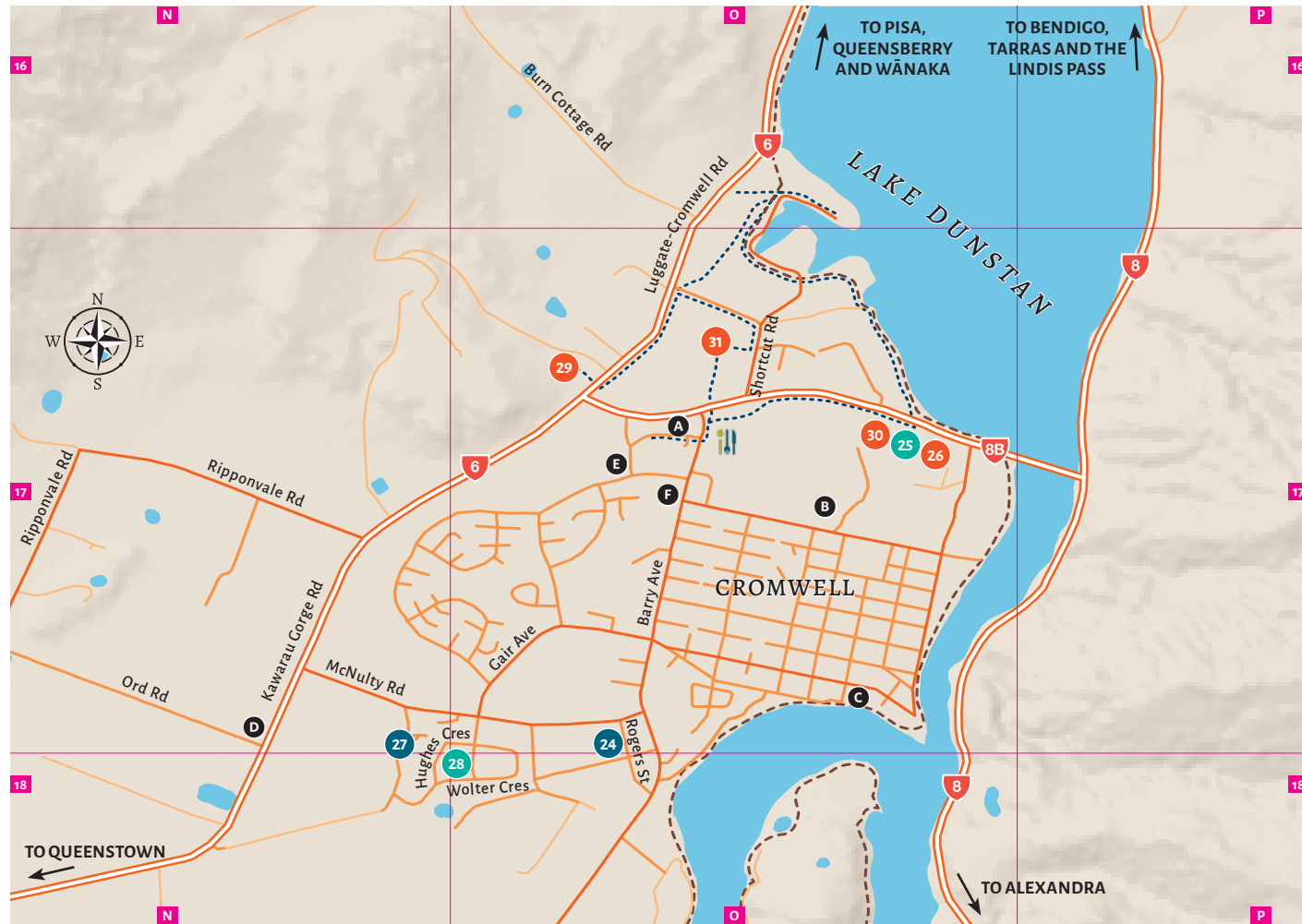

Suggested Itineraries

We recommend that you allow around 45mins to 1 hour to visit each winery to allow enough time to savour the wines, learn about the winery and the people behind the wine and enjoy the stunning landscapes and vistas of Central Otago.



½ day trip (excluding lunch)

From Queenstown: Explore the wineries of Gibbston and Queenstown. The Gibbston sub-region is 30 mins by car from central Queenstown. Many wineries in this region are open 7 days and offer restaurants and private wine tours and tastings. Refer to wineries individual listings or websites for their opening hours and wine experiences.

From Wānaka: There are a number of Cellar Doors open the majority of the year in the Wānaka region. It is also worth the drive to explore the nearby sub-regions of Bendigo, Tarras and Queensberry.

From Cromwell: Head up the west side of Lake Dunstan to visit the wineries at Lowburn and Pisa. A number of these Cellar Doors are open by appointment, so be sure to call ahead. Or drive a short distance up the east side of the lake towards Bendigo and Tarras and visit Northburn on the way with its picturesque views of the Pisa Mountain Range. Just a 10 minute drive south, is the Bannockburn sub-region which delivers spectacular views across the Cromwell Basin.

From Alexandra: On the north side of the river are the winegrowing areas of Alexandra and Clyde or head across the bridge and follow the southern bank of the Clutha River and drive through the picturesque Earnsclough Valley. Remember to phone ahead and make a reservation with wineries who are open by appointment.

1 Day

There are enough wineries in each sub-region to enjoy a full day wine tasting and a delicious lunch at one of the winery restaurants. Many Cellar Doors also offer other light snacks and platters.

3–5 Days

If you are in the region for longer, on day one visit the wineries in the Alexandra sub-region and take another day to explore Cromwell and Bannockburn. On the third day depart Cromwell and drive up the east side of Lake Dunstan to visit Northburn, Bendigo and Tarras. Take a detour to picturesque Lake Wānaka and return via the western side of Lake Dunstan and the winegrowing areas of Queensberry, Pisa and Lowburn. On your final day, take the time to explore the wineries of Gibbston and Queenstown.

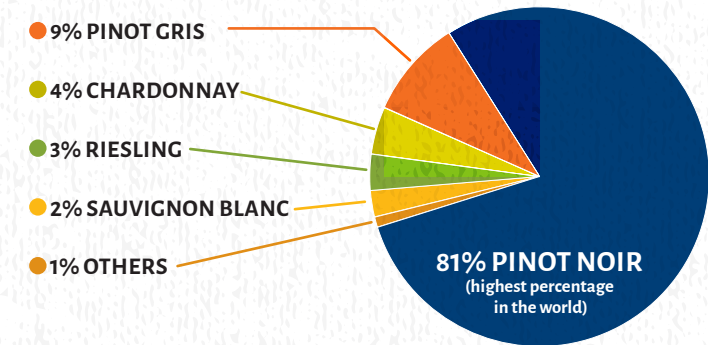

Key Central Otago Facts

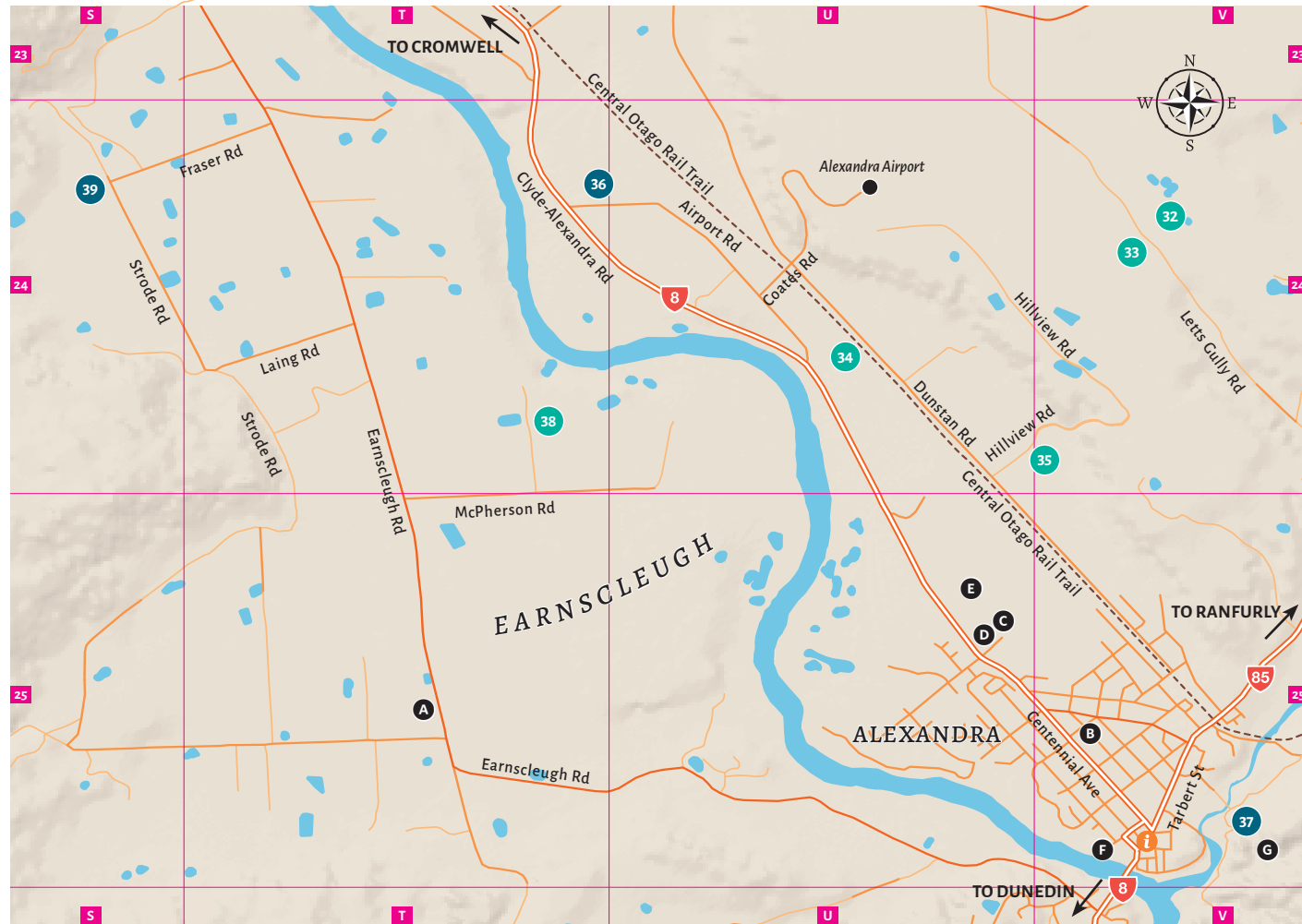
2000 hectares (4942 acres) planted (5% of New Zealand's planted vineyard area 39,934 hectares/98,679 acres)



- First commercial release of wine – 1987 (Pinot Noir from Gibbston Valley Wines)
- Grapes first planted: 1864 - see "History" on page 16
- Number of vineyards in Central Otago: 200+
- Average vineyard size: 9.6 hectares (24 acres)
- Average vine age: 14 years
- Number of people employed in the Central Otago wine industry: winter approx 300, summer approx 600, harvest approx 1,200
- Total tonnes grown: approx 8000–10,000t (560,000–700,000 cases)

Other Interesting Central Otago Wine Facts

- Vine Age: 3 years before first crop, 6 years until in full production, approx 100 years of economic life (compare this to some of the oldest vines in production for over 400 years old in Slovenia)
- Grapes in a bottle: 500–600
- Bunches on a vine: 20
- Grape berries in a bunch: 75–100
- Grape bunches in one glass of wine: 1–2
- Vines per hectare: 1667–10,000 (mostly between 1667–3000)
- Tonnes per hectares: 3–12 (average 5.5 tonnes per hectare, although this can vary greatly)
- Burgundy barrel size: 220 litres
- Barrels per hectare: 8–35 (average 16)
- Bottles per vine: 3
- Bottles per tonne: 850
- Bottles per hectare: 4600
- Cases per barrel: 24
- Glasses (150ml) per hectare: 30,600
- Glasses (150ml) in a bottle: 5
- Bottles (750ml) per 220 litre barrel: 290
- Average age of a French oak tree used to make barrels: 170 years
- Number of years an oak barrel is used: 5–8



4. ALEXANDRA

The Alexandra area was the first sub-region to be explored and planted. Feraud's 1864 plantings were in this area, and his stone winery still stands. The most southerly sub-region incorporates vineyards in and around Clyde, Earnsclough and Alexandra. The climate is dry and runs to extremes in both summer and winter. Spectacular schist outcrops dominate the arid landscape and the wide air temperature diurnal variation produces vividly varietal, aromatic and finely structured wines.

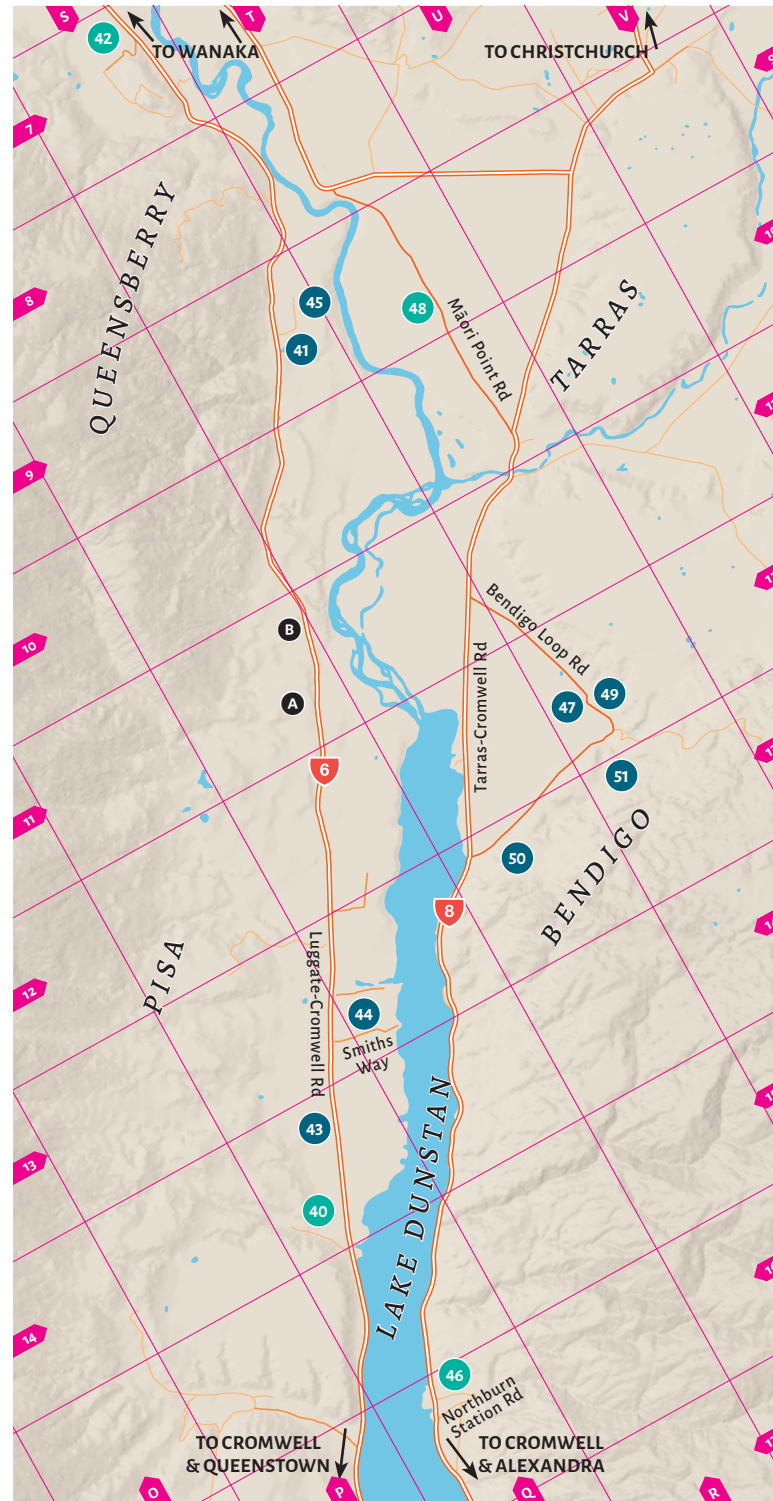


5. PISA & QUEENSBERRY

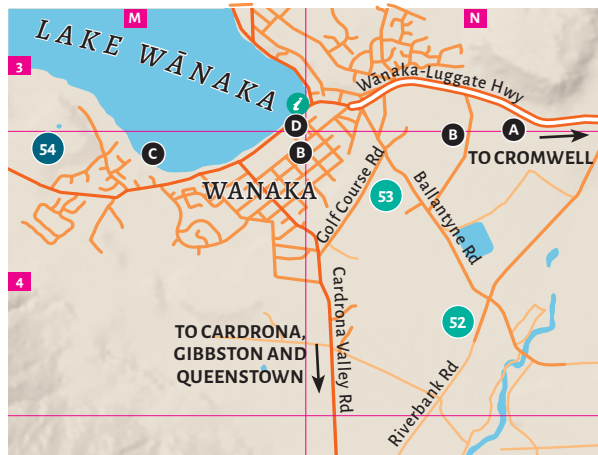

History

The first wine-making grapes were planted in Central Otago in 1864 by Frenchman John Desire Feraud. Coming from a wine-making family, he made his fortune in the Dunstan gold rush of 1862 and quickly recognised the region's outstanding potential for grape growing which was affirmed by the region's first gold medal for 'Burgundy' in Sydney in 1881. Feraud's stone built winery – Monte Christo in Clyde – still survives today. However, stonefruit plantings dominated until renewed interest and commitment by the 1970's Central Otago winemaking pioneers whose dream became reality with the first modern commercial production of a Central Otago wine in 1987. Rapid growth of the industry through the 1990s and 2000s has seen the Central Otago wine growing region expand to an area of 2,000 hectares, with over 100 wine brands producing approximately 700,000 cases of Central Otago wine annually.

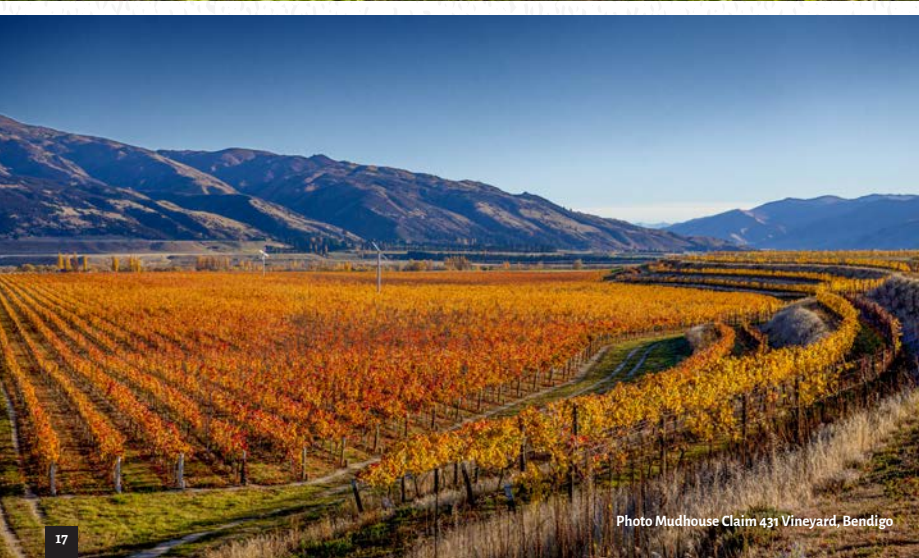
